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**TRANSIT RIDERS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TRAC) PSTA IMPROVEMENTS  
WORKSHOP #2 MINUTES  
MAY 15, 2018**

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Committee Chair Gloria Lepik-Corrigan called the May 15, 2018 TRAC/PSTA Improvements Workshop #2 to order at 4:40 PM. There was no public comment.

**TRAC SUGGESTIONS FOR PSTA IMPROVEMENTS**

Juan Luvian, Community Engagement Liaison, briefly reviewed the long list of improvements that was created at the April 17th TRAC/PSTA workshop facilitated by Nicole Dufva, Public Engagement Specialist. Mr. Luvian, along with TRAC Chair Lepik-Corrigan, and Cassandra Borchers, Chief Development Officer, managed to narrow all the ideas into two main focus areas relating to improving communication between riders and PSTA as a common thread: Rider Communication, Services and Accessibility, and Amenity Enhancements. After a lengthy discussion, the subcommittee members came to a consensus to focus on two PSTA improvements: Detours/Communication and Clean Shelters.

**NEXT STEP**

The Public Engagement team will inform and invite representatives from the PSTA departments responsible for the two improvements to present information at an upcoming TRAC meeting. The department representatives will inform the TRAC members of the process, procedures, number of staff needed, and the costs involved in the current system in place. TRAC and the PSTA department representatives must take the time to understand and discuss the feasibility of making fiscally responsible and achievable improvements in one or both of TRAC's chosen initiatives.
