



**PINELLAS SUNCOAST TRANSIT AUTHORITY**  
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**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**  
**OCTOBER 8, 2021**

Committee Chairperson Janet Long called the October 8, 2021 Legislative Committee meeting to order at 9:00 am. **Public Comment:**

**Action Items:**

**Approve September 1, 2021 Minutes** – Mr. Saracki made a motion, seconded by Mr. Robinson, to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

**Federal Legislative Priorities** – Mr. Miller outlined the draft Federal Legislative Priorities for 2022 including the Clearwater Transit Center, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, and FY2022 Appropriations.
