LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 5, 2022

Committee Vice-Chairperson Dan Saracki called the January 5, 2022 Legislative Committee meeting to order at 9:00 am. Members present: Dan Saracki, Jamie Robinson, Gina Driscoll, David Allbritton, and Jeff Gow. Members absent: Kathleen Peters. Also present: Brad Miller, CEO, and PSTA staff members. Attending via Zoom were: Ron Pierce, RSA Consulting; and Harry Glenn, Van Scoyoc.

Public Comment:

Action Items:

Elect Committee Chair/Vice-Chair – Committee Vice-Chairperson Saracki, made a motion, seconded by Mr. Gow, to elect Committee Vice-Chairperson Saracki to be the Chairperson.
