
- Fast: About 35 minutes from downtown to the beach

How to Navigate the Ins and Outs of the SunRunner's Bus Lanes






Bus Lanes Keep Everyone Moving

Look both ways and wait for "WALK" signal.

Tips for Drivers:

- **DO**: Enter bus lanes to make a turn
- **DO**: Look for buses before entering bus lanes
- DON'T: Drive in bus lanes for more than one block
- DON'T: Park or unload your vehicle in bus lanes
- DON'T: Pull in front of buses



Cars may enter bus lanes for up to a block when making a turn.

Bus lanes effective 24/7. Violators may be ticketed or towed.



The SunRunner uses the inside lane on 1st Ave. N. between 66th St. and 3rd St. and on 1st Ave. S. between S. Pasadena and 20th St.



The SunRunner uses the outside lane on 1st Ave. S. between 16th St. and 4th St.



The SunRunner uses the outside lane on S. Pasadena between Central Ave. and Huffman Way. Bikes are permitted in this section only.
