**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**  
**DECEMBER 1, 2021**

Committee Vice-Chairperson Dan Saracki called the December 1, 2021 Legislative Committee meeting to order at 9:03 am. Members present: Dan Saracki, Gina Driscoll, and David Allbritton. Members absent: Janet Long and Kathleen Peters. Also present: Board Member, Jeff Gow; Brad Miller, CEO; and PSTA staff members. Attending via Zoom were: Committee Member, Jamie Robinson; Ron Pierce, RSA Consulting; Harry Glenn and Steve Palmer, Van Scoyoc.

**Call to Order:**

Mr. Allbritton made a motion, seconded by Ms. Driscoll, to allow Mr. Robinson to participate via Zoom. Motion passed unanimously.

**Public Comment:**

There were no public comments.

**Action Items:**

**Approve October 8, 2021 Minutes** – Ms. Driscoll made a motion, seconded by Mr. Allbritton, to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

**Information Items:**

**State Legislative Update** – Mr. Pierce gave an update on the State Legislative issues including Transportation Network Companies (TNC), the VW settlement funds, Medicaid, and state transportation funding. A question was asked about funding, which Mr. Pierce answered.

**Federal Legislative Update** – Mr. Glenn and Mr. Palmer provided information on the Federal Legislative issues including the Infrastructure Bill, the Appropriations Bill, the Clearwater Transit Center project, and meetings in Tallahassee. Questions were asked about infrastructure funding, the Clearwater Transit Center, and the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity grant (RAISE), which Mr. Glenn and Mr. Palmer answered.

**Other Business:**

Committee Vice-Chairperson Saracki introduced incoming Legislative Committee member, Jeff Gow. Mr. Miller mentioned the collaboration agreement with PSTA and the Hillsborough Area Regional Transit Authority (HART).
